 \rightarrow Main character:

 \rightarrow **Problem:** What is the problem or crisis the hero faces at the beginning of the story?

→ **Desire:** Be specific!

→ **Opponent:** (How do you know?)

 \rightarrow Plan: List the series of battles that begins with the hero's plan of attack and continues with all the events (battles) that take place until reaching the final battle—the moment of crisis that will determine the outcome of the war which is intrinsically tied to the self-revelation.

 \rightarrow [Final] Battle: involves the hero and the main opponent and will decide, once and for all, who wins the goal; must be an intense experience—puts the hero to the ultimate test (crucible)

 \rightarrow Moral self-revelation: (Be specific about what the character learns.)

 \rightarrow New Equilibrium: What is the new balanced state, now that the war is over? Has the character risen to a higher level, or has he or she fallen to a lower one? What fundamental change has taken place as a result of the hero's going through his or her crucible?
